" A Muslim never lacks proofs about the purity and truthfulness of his religion, but what he lacks are those truthful brothers who stand for Allah and His prophet testifying to the Truth. Indeed, in this age, Islam is a religion without men (custodians and propagators) whereas Christianity is men without religion; yet, by their endeavors, adventurous spirit, patience, and monetary contributions they are able to falsify truth and make falsehood appear true. In this materialistic age most of humanity have become slaves to wealth, fashions, and mansions. "

## Purity of Quranic Text

Among all the religious books of the world, the Holy Quran is the only Book which enjoys the distinction of having a pure text. The factors contributing to this safe preservation of the text are its being reduced to writing under the Prophet himself and its being committed to memory by a large number of people, at the time of its revelation.

Ex. of writing in first revelation that came to the Prophet. 96:1-5 Read in the name of thy Lord.

... who taught by the pen  
as many as 42 companions serve as scribes at some time  
With Arabs, memory was the safest repository. Not only was it important to them as moral and social code, but they believed (rightly) that every word proceeded from a Divine source, hence each word was a heavenly treasure here on earth. Many were proud to not be able to write and took the arabic name ummi - or one whom memory serves the purpose of writing.

Claims to be greatest spiritual force which is destined to ultimately bring the whole of humanity to perfection - as seen in first + last verses:

1:1 Praise be to Allah, the Nourisher of the worlds to perfection.

114:1 Say, I seek refuge with the Nourisher of mankind to perfection.

## Unparalleled Transformation Wrought by Quran

No faith ever imparted such a new life to all branches of human activity; a transformation of the individual, the family, the society, the nation, the country; awakening material as well as moral, intellectual as well as spiritual.

Quran found the Arabs worshippers of idols, stones, trees, heaps of sand, and yet in less than a 1/4 of a century, the worship of One God ruled the whole country.

### A. In Scripture

VII. This is a Serious Day and Time, and we want to be careful to always conduct ourselves as Muslims (or as righteous people).

A) We must come into a strong love and identification with our leadership.

B) "The only way for us to ensure that leadership will stay strong among us is that we have to increase our recognition of the value and the importance of leadership. We have to increase our willingness to contribute to the building up and to the broadcasting of the leadership, and we must not be ashamed of our leadership."

C) Though Prophet Muhammad was the ~~exple~~ exemplary leader when it comes to democratic leadership, there were cases where he had to make a stand firmly against many of his followers.

① Though we have the same democratic leadership today, remember there is a superior mind in our midst to whom we should yield.

② In fact, we should present our ideas or contributions in a spirit of yielding.
